Qualifications Required: (a) Graduation from High School or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** one year of full-time paid (or the equivalent part-time and/or volunteer) experience in either maintenance work or general building construction or in one or more of the standard trades such as carpentry, plumbing, or electrical; **OR**

(b) Four years of full-time paid (or the equivalent part-time and/or volunteer) experience in either maintenance work or general building construction work in one or more of the standard trades such as carpentry, plumbing, or electrical; **OR**

(c) Possession of a certificate of completion in construction technology from a New York State accredited trade or technical school that provides instruction in the fields of carpentry, electrical, plumbing, HVAC or construction carpentry; **OR**

(d) Any combination of training and experience equal to or greater than that specified in (a), (b), or (c) above.

Special Requirements: All candidates must have NYSED fingerprint clearance. Possession of a valid NYS Driver's license to operate a motor vehicle at the time of application is required, and maintaining of such license for the duration of employment. Candidates who are currently certified as a NYS Class C Water Operator and/or Certified Pool Operator are preferred but not required at time of application.
